The adopted 'Residential Annexes Supplementary Planning Document' is a Local Development Document and forms part of the Local Development Framework for the Parishes comprising the former East Northamptonshire district. The document will supplement the Householder Extensions SPD and policies 2 and 8 of the North Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy, by providing local guidance and direction regarding the development of residential annexes (also known as "Granny Annexes"). Following adoption the SPD now has the status of a statutory Local Development Document, supplementing the Local Development Plan.
